



## **Academic Bee (30 tossups + 1 backup)**

### **Literature:** 6 tossups

Each round includes at least 1 American tossups, at least 1 British tossup, at least 1 non-Western tossup, and at least 2 non-American, non-British tossup.

### **History:** 6 tossups

Each round includes at least 1 American tossup, at least 1 Asian tossup, at least 2 European tossups, and at least 1 non-American, non-European tossup.

### **Science:** 6 tossups

Each round includes 2 biology tossups, 1 chemistry tossup, 1 physics tossup, 1 astronomy tossup, and 1 Earth science tossup.

### **Math:** 2 tossups

As with all Academic Bee and Bowl content, these questions require no computation.

### **Fine Arts:** 3 tossups

This includes at least 1 painting tossup and 1 classical music tossup; the third tossup in a round could be from sculpture, architecture, dance, film, opera, the musical aspects of ballet, jazz, or more painting or classical music.

### **Religion & Mythology:** 3 tossups

This includes any or all of world's major religions and myth systems, but focuses primarily on Christianity, Judaism, Islam, Buddhism, Hinduism, Greco-Roman, Egyptian, and Norse traditions.

### **Social Studies:** 4 tossups

Each round includes 2 geography tossups, 1 current events tossup, and 1 tossup from civics, American government, economics, philosophy, psychology, sociology, anthropology, or linguistics.

### **Backup Questions:** history, science, or literature



## **Academic Bowl**

**Literature:** 3 tossups, 3 bonuses, and 1 sixty-second round

Each round includes at least 1 tossup and 1 bonus in American literature and 1 tossup and 1 bonus in British literature.

**History:** 3 tossups, 3 bonuses, and 1 sixty-second round

Each round includes 1 tossup and 1 bonus in Asian history, 1 tossup and 1 bonus in European history, and 1 tossup and 1 bonus in non-Asian, non-European history.

**Science:** 3 tossups, 3 bonuses, and 1 sixty-second round

The tossups and bonuses cover biology, chemistry, physics, astronomy, and Earth science roughly equivalently, with a slight additional emphasis on biology.

**Math:** 1 tossup and 1 bonus

As with all Academic Bee and Bowl content, these questions require no computation.

**Fine Arts:** 2 tossups and 2 bonuses

This includes one question on visual arts (painting, sculpture, architecture, dance, film) and one question on auditory arts (classical music, opera, the musical aspects of ballet, jazz).

**Religion & Mythology:** 2 tossups and 2 bonuses

This includes any or all of world's major religions and myth systems, but focuses primarily on Christianity, Judaism, Islam, Buddhism, Hinduism, Greco-Roman, Egyptian, and Norse traditions.

**Social Studies:** 2 tossups and 2 bonuses

This includes 1 tossup and 1 bonus per round on geography and 1 tossup and 1 bonus from current events, civics, American government, economics, philosophy, psychology, sociology, anthropology, or linguistics.

**Backup Questions:** history, science, or literature
